

Read through all of the instructions before starting

For hardwiring installation,

we suggest hiring a professional electrician.



Make sure you have all parts and components before discarding any packing materials Do not over-tighten screws and bolts to avoid stripping the hardware or cracking the item.

Installation and electrical connections must follow local and National Electric Code standards.

Keep all components and packaging out of reach of children or animals to avoid risk of choking or suffocation.

Ensure the main power supply is OFF before starting work to prevent electrical shock

Check all parts and hardware for damage. If the product is damaged, it should not be used.

Allow the fixture to cool before changing the bulb. Fixture may get hot when in use.

Assemble your item on a flat, carpeted area, with plenty of space to work. This will prevent damage and scratches to your floors or the item while you're assembling the product.

We recommend LED bulbs. LEDs are better for energy consumption and can prolong the life of the fixture.

A Inner Hexagon Screw x1 B 2mm Allen Key x1 C Short Screw x2

+ One (1) E26 (medium-base) Light Bulb (MAX. 40W)



Step 1.1 Pulling out the power cable.


Step 1.2 Use the 2mm Allen Key (B) to unscrew the Inner Hexagon Screw (A), then attach the lamp shade onto round part of metal tube and tighten the Inner

Step 2.2 Install light bulb according to the wattage label (E26,G50 MAX. 40W, bulbs not included).

ATTENTION: To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage indicated on the wattage label.

Your lamp is complete and ready to enjoy.




CARING FOR YOUR ITEM
